Applications are open to all artists working in a variety of genres, with a particular focus and interest in community-based development.

The goal of the Grand Stafford Theater is to create a hub for local artistic endeavors that engage with the Bryan/ College Station community. Thus, our Musician-in-Residence program aims to develop musicians locally.

- Artists who successfully submit a full application will be notified by October 7th, 2015. In some cases, artists may be asked to clarify or provide additional information. Additionally, the selection committee may request

an interview with final candidates. This will either be completed in person, or if unable due to distance or cost, may be done via Skype.
